INFORMS

that, in compliance with the current Law, every operation concerning the process of personal data, even the sensitive ones, provided by submitting one's resume, processed at said business, will be based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency.

Pursuant to art. 13 of European Regulation 679/2016, I inform you that the processing of the data you supplied: 1) will be finalized exclusively to the research and selection of staff; 2) it is developed on hard and digital copy; 3) will be processed just by specifically trained personnel at the legal address of the company, in via Paolo Emilio 34-Roma; 4) the provision of data is optional and the possible denial could cause the impossibility to provide information concerning the procedures of staff selection and the omitted fulfillment of the pre-contractual obligations.

Please note that You are entitled to exercise the options provided for art. 8 and 13 of the European Regulation 679/2016. Notably, by simple request to the Data Controller or possibly the person in charge of the process, you will be able to find or not find the existence of personal data concerning yourself and receive any direction regarding the purpose and method of the process.

You are also entitled to update, rectify and cancel data that were not lawfully processed, by writing to the email address mentioned above. Ultimately, I remind You that you are also entitled, for legitimate reasons, to oppose to the processing of your personal data and to the process aimed at the distribution of advertisement, direct selling and the achievement of market research. You have also the right to lodge a complaint to the Data Protection Authority or to the competent Judicial Authorities.
